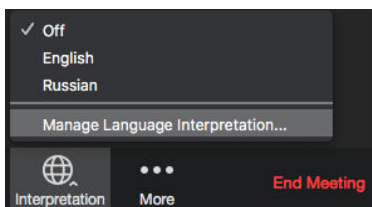

1. Technical Requirements

The conference will be broadcast via the ZOOM platform. The interpreter function can now also be used on mobile devices via the Zoom mobile app. The prerequisite is an update to the following versions: Windows: 5.2.1 (44052.0816) or higher; macOS: 5.2.1 (44040.0816) or higher). To activate the interpreter function, as you join the Zoom Meeting with the links provided below, just click on the globe in the bottom bar of the Zoom interface (see image).
